## I-5 South County Improvements Project

---

### Lane Reductions and Ramp Closures Beginning Tonight

Starting at 11 p.m. tonight, Friday, September 29th, the I-5 northbound freeway lanes will be reduced between Alicia Parkway and El Toro Road. Lane reductions will continue until Monday, October 2nd at 5 a.m.

Additionally, the I-5 NB El Toro Road loop on-ramp will be closed from 11 p.m. Friday, September 29th to 5 a.m. Monday, October 9th.

And the I-5 NB El Toro Road straight on-ramp will be closed from 11 p.m. Friday, September 29th to 5 a.m. Monday, October 2nd.
