STAY SAFE AS THE CLOCKS CHANGE

CRIME PREVENTION TIPS FOR DAYLIGHT SAVINGS

As we "spring forward", the shift in daylight hours can affect our daily routines and, unfortunately, provide opportunities for criminals to take advantage of the darker hours. With safety in mind, here are some crime prevention tips to help protect you and your home as we adjust to the time change:

Light Up the Night: Install motion-sensor lights around your home to deter burglars. A well-lit exterior makes your property less attractive to criminals.

Stay Aware After Dark: Be extra cautious when out in the evening. Stay alert, avoid isolated areas, and trust your instincts.

Update Your Security System: Ensure cameras and alarms are working and covering vulnerable spots on your property.

Hide Valuables: Keep valuables out of sight, especially when it's darker outside. Make your home less appealing to burglars.



Solid Waste and Recycling

On June 25, 2024, the City Council awarded a new solid waste and recycling contract to CR&R following a competitive bidding process. Starting July 1, 2025, CR&R will begin providing enhanced services, including new collection vehicles and containers. To prepare, all residents will receive new trash, recycling, and organics containers beginning in February

2025, with the full exchange completed by April 2025. Container swaps will occur on your regular service day. For specific dates and details on when your neighborhood will receive new containers or for more information about services, visit the City's Trash & Recycling Services page here. As required by California Senate Bill 1383 and City regulations, all residents must participate in the three-container waste collection system.

Ongoing Public Works Capital Improvement Projects

The following project has been awarded by City Council:

CIP 104/109 – Paseo de Valencia and La Paz Road Pavement Rehabilitation Project Scope of Work: Removal of deficient asphalt concrete pavement followed by construction of fiber reinforced asphalt hot mix overlay on Paseo de Valencia between Alicia Parkway and El Toro Road, and on La Paz Road between Alameda Avenue and West City Limits/SR-73. Also, curb ramp replacements throughout the limits of work and on Alicia Parkway between Paseo de Valencia and Moulton Parkway. This project also includes levelling La Paz


